- 1. In reference to RM No. 966, s. 2024, which outlines the conduct of training for Schools Division Offices (SDOs) in Baguio City, all concerned SDOs are hereby directed to submit their Division Intervention Plans as part of their final output for the said training.
- 2. The Division Intervention Plan must address the identified learning gaps within each division and align with the key objectives and strategies discussed during the training. The plan should be signed by the Schools Division Superintendent and must include:
  - Assessment of current challenges and gaps
  - Strategic interventions to address these gaps
  - Expected outcomes and monitoring mechanisms
- 3. An intervention plan template is attached to this Memorandum to guide all SDOs in the preparation of their plans.
- 4. The signed Division Intervention Plan must be submitted no later than October 18, 2024, with the hard copy submitted to the Regional Office and the soft copy uploaded to the respective Google Drive folder provided to each division during the training.
- 5. In addition, the finalized assessment reports, including the Test of Fundamental Academic Skills (TOFAS), Rapid Math Assessment (RMA), Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA), and Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI) for the 2023-2024 Beginning of School Year (BoSY), End of School Year (EoSY), and 2024-2025 Beginning of School Year (BoSY) assessments, must also be uploaded to the respective Google Drive folder not later than the submission deadline for the intervention plan.




#### Instructions:

- X. Expected Outcomes: State the anticipated outcomes that align with your objectives.




## Strategic Response Framework: Bridging Learning Gaps through Targeted Interventions


Section	Description / Content	
I. Context and Rationale	Provide an overview of the purpose of the intervention plan, summarizing the data analysis results that highlight the need for the intervention.	
II. Objectives	State the main objectives of the intervention based on the analysis of assessment data.  Objectives should address the identified learning gaps.	
III. Analysis of Data	Include a detailed summary of the consolidated assessment data results, highlighting key findings, trends, and any learning gaps identified.	
IV. Target SDOs	Identify the specific group of schools that will be the focus of the intervention. Mention characteristics such as school level, and educational needs.	
V. Intervention Strategies	Outline specific strategies and activities that will be implemented to address the learning gaps. Include instructional methods, materials, and expected outcomes.	
VI. Timeline	Provide a detailed timeline for the implementation of each intervention strategy, including milestones, checkpoints, and completion dates.


