## PROGRAM BRIEFER

### ACTIVITY NAME

The Boardroom

### OVERVIEW

The Boardroom offers students an exceptional chance to explore entrepreneurship by visiting the offices of some of the Philippines' top CEOs. This exclusive experience is designed to provide an immersive and enriching learning opportunity, potentially aiding them in their career mapping upon graduation senior high school.

### OBJECTIVES

1. Immersive Learning - Offer selected students a unique opportunity to immerse themselves in a boardroom-style learning environment, enriching their understanding of entrepreneurship and business leadership.
2. Engagement with Industry Leaders - Facilitate direct interaction and engagement between chosen students and CEOs, enabling them to gain insights from their vast experience in the entrepreneurial landscape.
3. Experiential Learning - Enhance participants' understanding of business operations through a potential visit to the CEO's office, offering a firsthand look at real-world business processes and industry practices.

### ACTIVITIES

1. Boardroom Learning Session - Engaging in a one-hour session held in a boardroom setting, delving into topics such as entrepreneurship, leadership, and innovation.
2. Interactive Discussion - Participating in discussions, sharing insights and engaging in dialogue to gain perspectives on business strategies and industry trends.
3. Office/Plant Visit (Optional) - Visiting the office/manufacturing plant can be arranged to provide students with an experiential learning opportunity to observe and learn about production processes and business operations.

### EXPECTED OUTCOMES

1. Enhanced Understanding on Entrepreneurship - Students will develop a deeper understanding of entrepreneurship and business leadership.
2. Insights from Industry Leaders - Direct interaction with industry leaders will enable students to gain invaluable insights.
3. Exposure to Real-World Business Practices - Students will gain exposure to real-world business practices, enriching their learning experience.

### **1. Participants**

- One nearby public school from the CEO's office
- Ten SHS students who demonstrate the following:
  - engaged in ABM, STEM, TVL and ALS strands
  - a keen interest in entrepreneurship
- One teacher adviser

### **2. Time Duration and Venue**

- About two hours
  - One hour boardroom mentorship
  - One hour office/plant tour (optional activity)
- CEO's boardroom

### **3. Attire**

- Business for CEOs
- School uniform for students

### **4. Logistics**

- School
  - Identify participants (10 students)
  - Provide contact details of the teacher adviser as point of contact
- Go Negosyo
  - Coordinate with the school and partner CEO
  - Secure consent and parent's waiver forms (release of photo and video to Go Negosyo and partner CEO's social media pages)
- Partner CEO
  - Provide transportation and meals (snacks and/or lunch) for the students and teacher
