



In 2013, the Department of Education (DepEd) implemented the K to12 Program under the Enhanced Basic Education Act (RA 10533), designed to streamline and standardize the basic education system. This reform aims to prepare Filipino learners for the challenges of the 21st century by making education more responsive, globally competitive, and relevant. The Senior High School (SHS) is a critical component of this program and is specifically designed to improve graduates' employability through Technical-Vocational programs, entrepreneurship, and college readiness.

To provide a comprehensive, quality, and complete basic education curriculum, the DepEd, through the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) will conduct Workshops on the Revision of Senior High School Curriculum: Specialized Subjects. Below is the schedule of activities:

Senior High School Curriculum Finalization: Specialized Subjects	December 9-13, 2024	National Capital Region


#### The activities aim to:
