Greetings from USAID Opportunity 2.0 (O2) Program!

I am reaching out to you in relation to the O2 Program's partnership with the Department of Education's (DepEd) Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) in the development of the Complementarity Framework between formal school and ALS. To provide a brief overview, O2 is a five-year program that aims to strengthen the education and workforce development systems that reach out-of-school youth (OSY) in the Philippines, preparing them to transition to further education, training, as well as immediate jobs and long-term success.

Last January 15, DepEd BAE, Bureau of Learning Delivery, and Bureau of Education Assessment met to initiate the discussion on the complementarity of formal and nonformal education programs offered by DepEd. In this meeting, the bureaus presented both the ALS and ADM programs and the various related national education assessments, and initiated a conversation on how best to align these various pathways of basic education. O2 organized the first roundtable discussion last April and came up with an initial draft of a Complementarity Framework. After the conduct of the first roundtable discussion and BAE's presentation to their committees, O2 will organize the second roundtable discussion with field level officials to further refine the framework and develop a proposed referral mechanism.

In line with this, we would like to invite Ms. Ena Tamayo, Ms. Christine Banzuela and Mr. Mark Ryan Romero to participate in the Roundtable Discussion II on the Development of Complementarity Framework Between Formal School System and Alternative Learning System (ALS) scheduled on November 25-26 in Astoria Plaza, Pasig City. Their participation would ensure that the developed resources will be of help in refining the said framework. Transportation, meals, and other incidental expenses shall be charged against O2 funds.
