

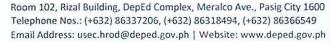

based educational projects

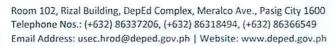

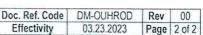
