In line with its commitment to the 'Media and Information Literacy for All' campaign, the National Council for Children's Television (NCCT) participated in the annual **Global Media and Information Literacy Week Celebration**, led by UNESCO. The NCCT's initiative focused on how media and information literacy (MIL) can help navigate the complexities of the digital landscape, particularly in addressing the challenges posed by AI-generated content and misinformation.

In partnership with various organizations, the NCCT, through its Media and Information Literacy Education Section (MILES), organized a project aimed at promoting MIL across the country which culminated on November 9, 2024. Among the highlights was the **National Quiz Bee on Media and Information Literacy**, which engaged young learners from various regions in showcasing their understanding and appreciation of the importance of being critical and informed consumers of media. Another significant feature was the **National Contest for Outstanding MIL-Integrated Lesson Plans**, which provided K-12 educators with an opportunity to demonstrate their creativity in incorporating MIL into their teaching practices.
