

IA is currently preparing for the revival of *Pasyal Aral*, one of its flagship programs, which brings elementary and high school students to Intramuros for an educational tour.



PASYAL ARAL SA INTRAMUROS

I. BACKGROUND

Pasyal Aral sa Intramuros is one of the flagship programs of the Intramuros Administration under the Tourism Promotions Division (TPD) of the Intramuros Administration (IA) which brings elementary and high school students to Intramuros for a free educational tour. In the past, thousands of students from over 300 schools in different cities and municipalities of the National Capital Region (NCR) were able to participate in this program.

This *Pasyal Aral* program aims to promote Intramuros being an important historical and cultural heritage site of our country. This will also provide a valuable learning experience to the young generation about history, culture and arts.

In line with this, TPD proposes the revival of the said program, with an initial run to be held within 23 to 31 January 2025.

II. RATIONALE AND JUSTIFICATION

The revival of the *Pasyal Aral sa Intramuros* aligns with the mission of the Intramuros Administration to contribute to the strengthening of the Filipinos' national identity and sense of belonging and pride. This program also provides additional learning experience for Filipino students that will further establish their historical knowledge and civic consciousness as citizens of our country.

Moreover, this program supports the vision of the Department of Education (DepEd) to build up young Filipinos who passionately love their country and will eventually contribute to building the nation. Lastly, aligned with the mission of DepEd, this will promote an active engagement among different communities to further help in developing life-long learners.

III. BENEFITS/OBJECTIVES

The proposed revival of Pasyal Aral sa Intramuros aims to:

- Celebrate and promote the rich history and cultural heritage of Intramuros;
- Provide a valuable learning experience to the young generation about history, culture and arts;







- Contribute to the strengthening of the national identity and sense of belonging and pride of young Filipinos; and
- Support the Department of Education (DepEd) in building up patriotic Filipino students with passion for learning.

V. PROPOSED IMPLEMENTATION

For the initial run of Pasyal Aral in 2025, TPD is proposing to cover four hundred fifty (450) Grade 6 students from public schools in nine cities within Metro Manila. A half-day tour itinerary will cover Fort Santiago, Baluarte de San Diego, Casa Manila, and Centro de Turismo Intramuros.
