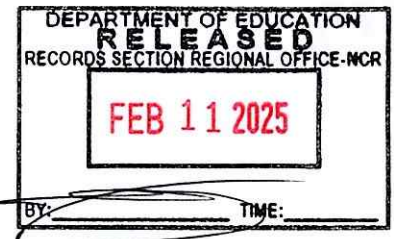

**MONITORING OF LEARNER RIGHTS AND PROTECTION BULLYING
CASES IN NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION**

1. This is relative to the monitoring of received bullying cases in the National Capital Region (NCR) referred to the Regional Office and Schools Division Offices by the Learner Rights and Protection Division – Learners TeleSafe Contact Center Helpline (LRPD-LTCCH) which remains unresolved to this date in the database due to non-compliance by the concerned SDOs. DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2013, Sec 14, Sanctions for Non-Compliance “*School personnel of public kindergarten, elementary or secondary schools **who fail to comply** with the provisions of the Act or this IRR shall be **subject to administrative disciplinary proceedings** in accordance with the Civil Service Rules and the relevant issuances of the Department of Education.*” This provision highlights the importance of adhering to the Department of Education’s policies, particularly in ensuring the protection of learners’ rights and timely resolution of bullying incidents, and serves as a reminder to DepEd personnel of their legal duty to safeguard learners and compels rigorous action on unresolved cases stemming from non-compliance.

2. Relative to this, all Schools Division Offices are requested to justify the LRP case/s status (Column T of the report template). Please impress in the column provided the implemented intervention program to the bully, bullied, and bystander-learners, actions taken, and or referral of the case by the School Child Protection Committee.

3. In addition, offices and school personnel involved in the verification of cases are reminded to handle with utmost confidentiality all LRP cases for the protection of learners in accordance with Section 18 of D.O. No. 40, s. 2012, and Section 11 of D.O. No. 55, s. 2013.
