

The Department of Education (DepEd) has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the **Asia Society for Social Improvement and Sustainable Transformation (ASSIST),** an international non-governmental organization focused on capacity building to promote sustainable practices to address social problems in the developing world.

The **Circular Explorer Project** stands as a flagship initiative of Holcim and One Earth-One Ocean, showcasing a pioneering recycling catamaran powered entirely by renewable energy. Its mission is to safeguard our oceans by retrieving plastic waste from rivers and seas for recycling and reutilization.

In support of this endeavor, ASSIST spearheads the Education Pillar, aiming to empower the next generation of changemakers with enhanced access to learning materials and immersive education experiences focused on circular economy principles and sustainability. DepEd supports the Circular Explorer project in rolling out circular economy modules and materials to public schools in key priority areas to empower students to become "Circularity Heroes," advocates for sustainability who will promote waste reduction, resource efficiency, and community engagement.

The roll-out of the Circular Explorer project will begin with the conduct of a **Training of Trainers (TOT)** on **March 29, 2025, at the Century Park Hotel in Pasay City.** The morning session will take place from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM for participants from SDO Manila and SDO Pasay. The afternoon session will be held from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM for participants from SDO Parañaque and SDO Las Piñas.

The objectives of the TOT are as follows:

- Equip 50-100 teaching and non-teaching personnel with the knowledge and resources to effectively explain Circular Economy concepts to students and youth.
- Provide strategies for integrating the Circular Explorer Toolkit into the School Rollout for maximum impact.
- Adapt and retrofit teaching approaches based on the trainer's existing skills and the needs of the participants.
