This Bureau, through the Education Assessment Division (EAD), will conduct a Standard Setting Workshop cum Table of Specification (TOS) Review and Skill Audit for the Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Test on April 1-4, 2025. This workshop has critical components in ensuring the validity, fairness, and accuracy of A&E Test in evaluating ALS learners who are aiming for certification. 

4. Skills and Abilities	He/She must be able to communicate well, work well
,	in a collaborative setting, and dedicated to meet the

5. Physical Fitness	He/She must be physically fit to participate in this
	activity. If he/she has a certain medical condition,
	he/she should disclose their health status
	confidentially before the start of the workshop.
