This Bureau, through the Education Assessment Division (EAD), will conduct a **Standard Setting Workshop cum Table of Specification (TOS) Review and Skill Audit for the Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Test** on April 1-4, 2025. The specific time, venue, and meals to serve for these activities shall be announced in a separate issuance.

This workshop has critical components in ensuring the validity, fairness, and accuracy of A&E Test in evaluating ALS learners who are aiming for certification. **Standard Setting Workshop** is a process used to define the score level or cut-off score that separates different performance levels in the test. It ensures that the test scores reflect the level of knowledge, skills, and competencies expected for ALS passers to be accredited in a particular grade level. On the other hand, the **Table of Specification (TOS) Review** aims to map out the learning competencies to be tested vis-à-vis the desired learning outcomes and ensure balanced representation of various topics in ALS 2.0 Curriculum.

Moreover, the criteria for selecting **Learning Strand Expert** are as follows:

Criteria	Specification
1. Qualifications	He/She must be an ALS teachers , who are DepEd-employed teachers implementing the ALS program. Preferably, he/she must be at least Teacher III.
2. Experience	Preferably, he/she must have at least five (5) years teaching experience in ALS with familiarity in ALS framework/curriculum.
3. Education and Training	He/She must have a Bachelor's degree relevant/related to the subject area/specialization. Certifications or training related to ALS teaching is an advantage.
4. Skills and Abilities	He/She must be able to communicate well, work well in a collaborative setting, and dedicated to meet the desired outputs of the day.
5. Physical Fitness	He/She must be physically fit to participate in this activity. If he/she has a certain medical condition, he/she should disclose their health status confidentially before the start of the workshop.
